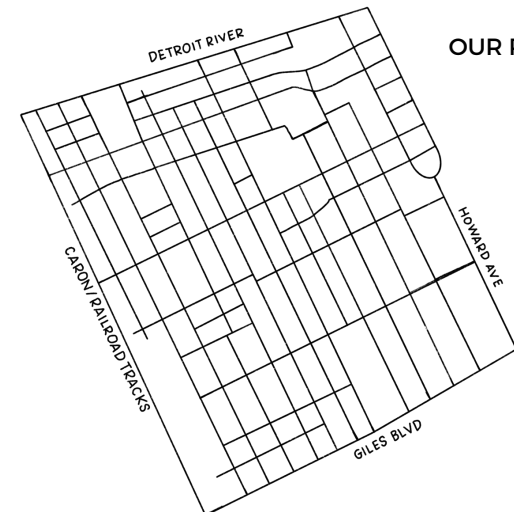

What Are My OPTIONS?

1 Week:

Observe through immersion for one week in the activities of DWCC experiencing the effect of interwoven ministries located within a defined geography. Experience the impact at an interpersonal level and community. Reflect on the creative work of the Spirit in multifaceted levels in the person and the community.

1 Month:

Participate through immersion for one month in the activities of DWCC experiencing the effect of interwoven ministries located within a defined geography. Experience and reflect on the creative work of the Spirit in multifaceted levels in the person and the community. Mentorship by one staff person on key vocational decisions.



Semester:

Participate and reflect through immersion for three months in the activities of DWCC experiencing the effect of interwoven ministries located within a defined geography. Experience and reflect on the creative work of the Spirit in multifaceted levels in the person and the community. Mentorship by one staff person on key vocational decisions. Additional structured curriculum on key concepts including parish, mission in 21st Century in Canada. Consideration for living downtown.

1 Year Internship:

Participate and reflect through immersion for three months in the activities of DWCC experiencing the effect of interwoven ministries located within a defined geography. Experience and reflect on the creative work of the Spirit in multifaceted levels in the person and the community. Mentorship by one staff person on key vocational decisions. Additional structured curriculum on key concepts including parish, mission in 21st Century in Canada. Participate in the neo-monastic life of DWCC through living in the downtown core. Honorarium provided.
